Triage and the use of personal protective equipment (PPE)

Karolinska Institutet has developed two COVID-19 e-trainings on behalf of the National Board of Health and Welfare. The purpose of the trainings is to strengthen preparedness and create a deeper understanding of the most important principles and challenges in the effort to prevent the spread of COVID-19. The focus is on infection control principles and the use of personal protective equipment.
